Some vaccinations are chargeable to our patients and you will be expected to pay for your vaccinations / course of vaccinations at your first appointment.

Travel vaccination fees

Malaria tablets are sometimes purchased from a pharmacy or a private prescription is required for malaria (the pharmacy will also charge you for the drug).
